



Parent Code Of Conduct

Parents play a MAJOR role in the development of their children, while members and players within 925 Baseball Club. Therefore, it is critical parents follow the code of conduct stated below:

- Be a positive role model through their own actions to make sure their child has the best experience possible
- Be a fan of the TEAM, not just a fan of your PLAYER
- Absolutely NO entering DUGOUTS, PRACTICE FIELDS, unless requested or asked by a member of the 925 Baseball or Softball staff (Injuries are the only exception)
- 48-hour rule; do not contact a coach regarding your child's performance after, during, or before a game. Allow 48 hours and then contact your coach to set up a conversation. (Please respect this rule)
- Show respect for the opposing players, coaches, and spectators
- Be respectful of all UMPIRE decisions (DO NOT embarrass the club by arguing calls)
- Do not instruct (COACH) your player DURING a game, as it may conflict with the coach's plans and strategies
- Please help your child learn that success is experienced in the development of their skills and that they can feel good about themselves, win or lose
- Address problems or concerns with coaches and directors in an appropriate manner, including proper time and place (48 hour rule). Be sure to follow the chain of command (HEAD coach first, then President)
- Do not engage in any behavior which would endanger the health, safety or well-being of any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee
- Encourage your child to treat ANY coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee with respect regardless of race, creed, national origin, sex, sexual orientation or ability
- Do not encourage your child, or any other person, to initiate a fight or scuffle with any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee
- Respect the Coaches and program Director's decisions. 925 Baseball Club is always looking out for the best interest of the player

Failure to abide to the code while attending, coaching, officiating or participating at Best Speed sporting events will be subject to disciplinary action, including but not limited to the following in any order or combination:

1. Verbal warning issued by a 925 Baseball Club Staff Representative
2. Immediate ejection from that event, and/or suspension from club.
3. If multiple offenses occur, suspension from all 925 Baseball Club activities for a minimum of a week (Possible more if the infraction is deemed such)
